

## Limes Farm Junior School Headline Data 2017-18

In terms of the progress the children made (judged from the end of Year 2 to the end of Year 6), the new government system gives a 'value-added' measure where the progress of each Year 6 pupil is compared with every child in the country who achieved similar results in Year 2. On that basis, the Year 6 cohort at Limes Farm Junior School achieved sufficient progress scores in all three subjects.

### Context of school:

Of the 43 pupils in our Y6 cohort, two pupils (educated abroad) did not have Key Stage 1 data therefore they were not included in the overall data published; although school data shows very good progress made by these pupils.

51% of the Y6 cohort have English as an additional language, 40% of pupils are Pupil Premium and 26% of pupils are SEN.
